

The authors focus on the business process and examine the activities from both an external, financial reporting perspective and an internal, management decision making perspective. Financial and Managerial Accounting are important subsystems of the same accounting information system, but serve different user groups.

The approach taken to accounting is a business process perspective. Within this framework, the performance phase is when information is captured and recorded in the financial accounting system. This approach allows students to understand that accounting is a vital link between business processes and business decisions in a complex environment.




