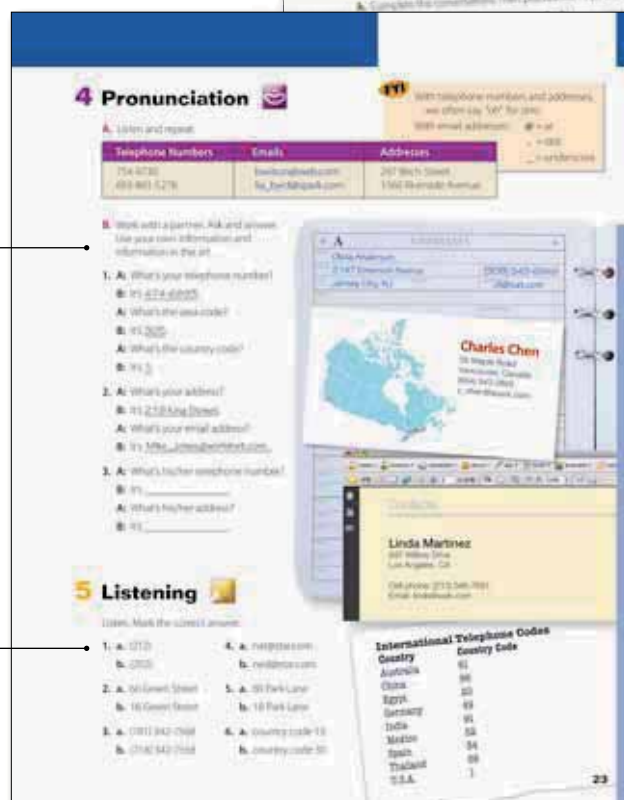
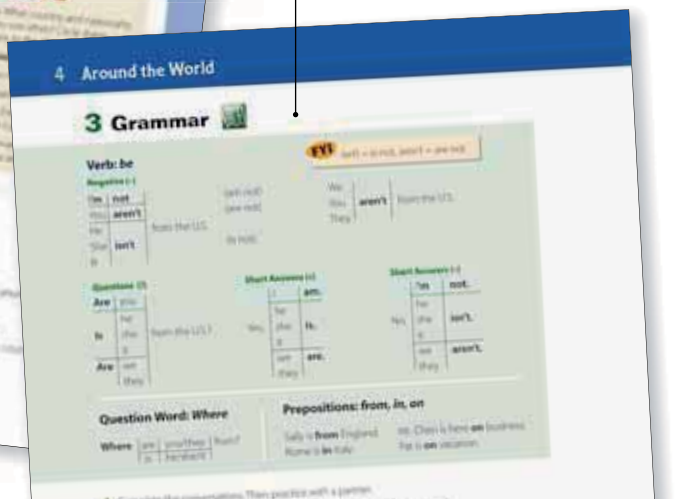




Unit openers, enhanced by attractive and contemporary illustrations, help students make visual connections and retain the new language.
